The pound has been weakening since January which has made imports more expensive. Last week the USDA was neutral and has not changed the outlook of things.

Sepra reports that the UK egg market is pretty static. There has been reports of free range producer price drops but we have not had any confirmation of this. There have also been quite a lot of Spanish and French eggs coming into England which has been *suppressing* prices. Wholesale prices of Chicken and Turkey have remained fairly static over the past couple of weeks.

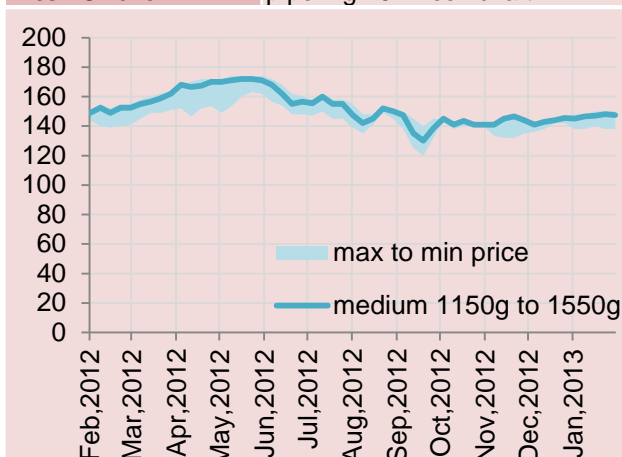

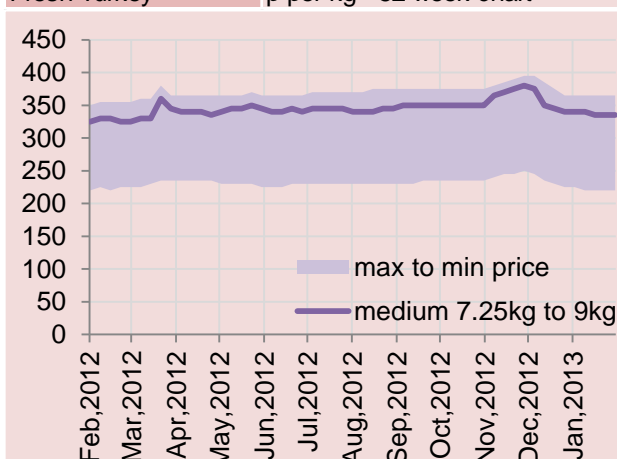

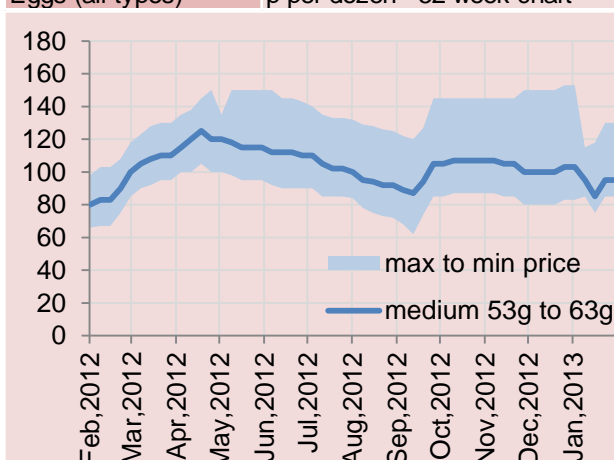
Fresh Chicken p per kg - 52 week chart
